## **SAFETY WARNINGS**



Watch out for Poison Ivy which has shiny leaves of three and grows along the forest edge.



The deer tick is a carrier of lyme disease. This scale is actual life size. Ticks should be removed within 24 hours to avoid potential disease transmission. Observed potential disease transmission. Check yourself, children, and pets after leaving the park.



West Nile Virus is a mosquito transmitted disease that can be carried by birds such as crows. Please inform the caretaker if you see a dead bird.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1) Pack-It-In, Pack-It-Out trash-free facility.
- Remove all trash generated by your activity.
- □Remove all pet waste "doggie bags" are provided.
- 2) No smoking allowed in the park.
- 3) No alcohol or illegal substances are allowed.
- 4) Pets are not allowed in the playground area. They must remain
- on the paths and trails.
- 5) No fires or table-top grills.
- 6) Park closes at dusk.
- 7) No overnight parking.
- 8) Zip line ride is for children 5 -12 and less than 100 lbs.
- 9) Park is open from mid-April through mid-November.
